## Appendix 7: Bible Study for Congregational Decision-Making from Teaching Biblical Faith: Leading Small Group Bible Studies, Leader's Guide

- 1. Begin with prayer.
- 2. Read the text. (For this study, read either Matthew 11:2-6 or Luke 7:18-23.)
- 3. See Ask what is happening in the text, why is it happening, and who is being affected.
- 4. Judge Connect the passage with your life experience. Name what your values, your beliefs, and your faith say about this. Consider together what you think should be happening.
- 5. Act/Discern Take a risk and name something in your life and community that this study has called you to address. Note what action you will take.
- 6. Close by sharing commitments and prayer.

As you are preparing your Bible study, remember:

- Pay attention to the people you are teaching.
- Pay attention to the text.
- Pay attention to the teaching process.
